

That Council receive and note the Finance Report for the 12 May 2023 Special Council Meeting and contract Scout Talent to recruit to the Chief Executive position.

SUMMARY:

This report summarises the CEO Recruitment agenda item for council's consideration and approval.

BACKGROUND

Council previously preferred Leading Roles to McArthur to assist with CEO recruitment. Leading Roles pulled out from the engagement for their own reasons.

NTG LG Compliance recommended BRC go back to the market to obtain further quotes for council's consideration to approve new agencies to assist with the recruitment.

The withdrawal by Leading Roles necessitated BRC to seek alternative recruitment agencies of which Frontier Human Resources out of Adelaide was contacted.

We requested Frontier Human Resources to provide a quote – not received at the time this report was released.

Scout Talent submitted a quote for \$13,945 (attached) which we request the council to consider. Julalikari Council Aboriginal Corporation has contracted this company to recruit its CEO.

This report summarises the Migration from tech one update for council's consideration and noting at the 12 May 2023 Special Council Meeting.

BACKGROUND

Migration from Tech one to:

1. Xero for financial reporting

All finance staff have undergone training in Xero. Chart of accounts has been mapped based on tech one configuration to enable migration of data.

Parallel run is underway until FY23 audit is finalised at which stage we go live.

2. Councilwise for rates

All historical rates data was extracted from tech one & uploaded into councilwise & configured smoothly.

Online user-training is currently underway. In-person training will happen from 29/5. Go live date is 6 June.

1. Approvalmax for purchase orders

This has been set up.

User training manual has been finalised and face-to-face training will happen for all managers from week of 10 June to afford users time to better understand how the new purchase order system works.



Mary James - Kulumindini Artists Title: 'Bushfire Along the Creek'


Story: "You got the creek there and the bushfires. Fire and water. The little dots are embers."



Janet Thompson - Canteen Creek artists Title: 'Sugarbag'


Story: "This pattern represents sugarbag; in Alyawarr language: ngkwarl arwengalker"

The native bee-hives known as sugarbag are found in hollows in trees, in the ground, and in termite mounds, with different names depending where they are located. The hives have a dark, sweet honey that is sought-after for eating, and yellow eggs and pollen which are tasty and good for medicine. The hard wax at the bottom of the hives cannot be eaten but can be used along with kangaroo tendons to bind spearheads to their shafts. One way to find native bee-hives is by noticing if there are lots of bees caught in a spider web, which tells you that there must be a hive located nearby."




