SUMMARY:

As the end of the year rapidly approaches we are working hard to finalise numerous items. With COVID19 raising it's head is SA again, we hope this does not spread and cause delays to any projects. We will be watching the situation closely and I continue to attend the regular Southern Region and Local Emergency Management Meetings.

I am pleased to report the Annual report was lodged ahead of time and printed copies have arrived if you would like a copy.

The Tennant Creek landfill remains Councils top priority and is progressing well, we expect to move back onto Lot 2161 shortly.

We have no further updates on the Purkiss reserve redevelopment, I am meeting with DIPL representatives regular and have been advised the tender responses are being prepared for evaluation. This has dragged on for well over a month without any further update. The existing toilets have been prepared for disconnection and fenced off in preparation for works to start.

I was fortunate to be able to meet with Mr Bruce Stalder, the CEO of Football (Soccer) NT. The meeting was very informative and Bruce was certainly an engaging personality. He was here to take part in the joint Moriarty/Sports Hub football competition held on the 14th. The event was very well attended but unbelievably cut short by a thunder storm. Our Sports officers continue to gain momentum and are certainly growing sports in the region.

The Mayor and I also met with Minister Lauren Moss during the month. The minister was in town for several days and we had the opportunity to discuss our Youth issues and some possible programs to improve the situation. The meeting went very well and it's very pleasing to see Ministers visiting Council again.

With only 3 weeks to Christmas many businesses will start winding down for the Christmas break. Council office's will remain open on business days throughout the Christmas period. Many Council staff will go on leave over this period and we'll run on reduced staffing for a couple of weeks over Christmas. I will be taking a month off and would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your work assisting Council during the year wish you a merry Christmas and a safe and prosperous new year.

This Report is a summary of Council meetings for November 2020.

BACKGROUND

The November 2020 Council meeting was very productive. The councillors were given an Australia day brief. The theme for this year's Australia Day is "emerging." Council will vote for all the categories at the December Council meeting. Councillors were urged to encourage the community to submit their applications before the deadline.

Mayor McLaughlin had a busy month meeting his counterparts from around the territory at the LGANT meeting in Alice Springs. He also met with various other people in different capacities including Minister Moss in regards to youth and education in the Barkly.

Council approved the Sponsorship of the Tennant Creek Christmas tree event, which will be held at the Tennant Creek Civic Hall.

In Elliott, the accommodation expression of interest was decided in favour of Northern Interest. The Tender for the Elliott football oval change rooms has been finalised and we are waiting for confirmation from the funding body to issue the contract..

The Ampilatwatja Ablution block tender was also awarded conditional to funding being finalised, with the Ampilatwatja Local Authority also putting some money towards the upcoming development.

Lastly, the Lake Mary Ann Dam Playground tender was also awarded with construction to commence in February. Council will be starting 2021 with a number of projects moving into construction phase, which is very exciting.
