BACKGROUND

Using Survey Monkey, a survey was launched on the afternoon of Thursday, 31 January, via email, the Council website and Facebook. The survey comprised of 10 questions with more than 130 responses by 11am on Thursday, 1 February 2018.

A quick analysis of the data showed that many of the survey respondents wished for extra facilities at Lake Mary Ann, including a larger kid's playground, a dog park and boating facilities. The larger kid's playground received the most votes and respondents would also like to see more events held out there.

Data from the survey, collected on the morning of Monday, 5 February, has been printed out in a separate document. Once the data is analysed by members of the TCLA, more or different types of questions can be compiled or another survey launched. Using the free Survey Monkey template Council was restricted to 10 questions only and a handful of surveys. However, Council recently upgraded the service to allow unlimited questions and templates for future surveys.

SUMMARY:

The information below outlines the activities of Barkly Regional Council since the last Local Authority meeting.

BACKGROUND

The CEO is currently on annual leave and Mr Gary Pemberton has acted in the capacity of Acting-CEO.

Council held the December 2017 council meeting on Thursday the 14th of December, and the January council meeting on Thursday the 25th of January. A number of topics were discussed during the meeting with some of these being very relevant to the Local Authority in particular:

- Development of a policy and position statement on domestic violence, development
 of a domestic violence action plan, "No More" signange at Purkiss reserve. And the
 development of an implementation plan for the policy, including training/education to
 ensure it is embedded throughout the organization, including the use of the "No
 More" logo in Council's corporate identity.
- Council has endorsed and offered comment on initial drafts of the Tennant Creek Footpath Replacement, Renewal and Extension Plan, which will be incorporated into Council's short-to-medium term financial planning commencing with the 2018-2019 budget cycle.

A summary of Local Authority Infrastructure priorities was presented to Council in the draft 5-yr Infrastructure Management Plan. The Mayor and Acting-CEO met with Senator Nigel Scullion. Discussions included presentation of Council's draft plan, together with a briefing in respect to the new Council, its aims, objectives, achievements to date and the challenges faced by Council and our constituent communities.

There has been no further formal activity in respect to Purkiss Reserve. It should be noted that, although The Tennant Creek Purkiss Reserve Various Upgrades Project was announced by the Gunner Labour Government and \$5 Million towards the Purkiss Reserve Master Plan has been allocated, no formal funding agreement is in place to facilitate further activity to move the project forward.

Council's 2018/2019 Corporate plan, Annual plan, and budget processes commence with the first budget meeting scheduled for 13 February and an initial strategic planning workshops with Councillors to be held 22 February.

Two local school leavers have now commenced with Council's Finance Department. Each has committed to a future development and education plan to ensure the retention of identified local talent within Council's workforce.

The CEO will return from holidays Monday February 5th.
