Mayor donates prize to kick-start Christmas Tree fundraising for 2023

Mayor Jeffrey McLaughlin has kicked off Tennant Creek Christmas Tree fundraising for 2023 with a \$300 cash donation.

Mayor Jeffrey won the \$300 prize by claiming first place in the Australia Day Triathlon, pipping fellow competitor Dr Rael Codron at the post.

The Australia Day celebrations last week were a fantastic show of community unity, with a 100-strong crowd at the annual Breakfast and Citizenship and Local Government Australia Day Award ceremonies.

Councillor Dianne Stokes, a Native Title holder for Tennant Creek, conducted the Welcome to Country, before guests rose for the National Anthem and Flag-Raising Ceremony conducted by the Tennant Creek Girl Guides.

Local business Red Centre Café catered a delicious breakfast, before emcee Member for Barkly Steve Edgington continued proceedings to welcome five new citizens.
