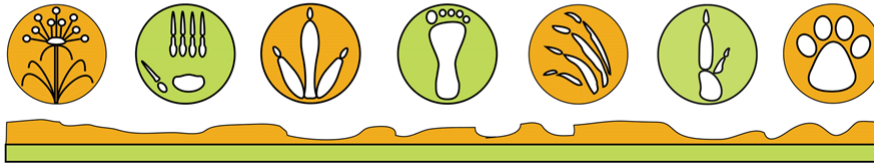

## **Free grant writing workshop**

Individuals and organisations of Tennant Creek took advantage of a free grant writing workshop on offer at Barkly Regional Council chambers today (Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> September).

Presented by Regional Development Australia Northern Territory (RDA NT), the three-hour grant writing workshop delivered an overview of the funding environment in Australia.

Brooke Rankmore, Project Officer for RDA NT, told participants where to look for grants, how to write a great grant application and key information that needs to be provided.

She also offered tips on how to improve grant success rate, common mistakes to avoid and spoke of alternative fundraising options.

Supported and hosted by Barkly Regional Council, BRC President Barb Shaw said this was an amazing opportunity for local people provided by RDA NT.
